Recognizing a Spiritual Con Colossians 2:16-23

And, in fact, Colossians 2 helps Christ-followers to **recognize three ways a believer can be spiritually conned**.

• BELIEVERS CAN BE CONNED WITH <u>LEGALISM</u>.

Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. ¹⁷These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ. Colossians 2:16-17 (New International Version)

Definition: "Legalism is any attempt to <u>help God out</u> with extra <u>rules and</u> <u>regulations</u>." Dr. Larry Osborne

The Extra Rules

• What you eat or drink (Old Testament dietary laws—See Leviticus 11)

Again Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this. ¹⁵Nothing outside a man can make him 'unclean' by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him 'unclean'" ¹⁷After he had left the crowd and entered the house, his disciples asked him about this parable. ¹⁸"Are you so dull?" he asked. "Don't you see that nothing that enters a man from the outside can make him 'unclean'? ¹⁹For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body." (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods "clean.") Mark 7:14-19 (NIV) See also 1 Corinthians 8:8; Romans 14.

• The Celebration of certain days (the Jewish religious calendar, the Sabbath Day—See Exodus 5:15; 31:13-17; Hebrews 8)

• BELIEVERS CAN BE CONNED WITH MYSTICISM.

Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. ¹⁹He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. Colossians 2:18-19 (NIV)

Mysticism = the pursuit of spiritual truth through subjective experiences, apart from God's Word or God's Spirit

"... what he has seen" = best scholarship = "mystical visions"

• BELIEVERS CAN BE CONNED WITH ASCETICISM.

Since you died with Christ to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules: ²¹"Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"? ²²These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based on human commands and teachings. ²³Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence. Colossians 2:20-23 (NIV)

Ascetic = someone who lives a life of <u>rigorous self-denial</u> in order to become more spiritual.

TAKEAWAY: Don't get conned into doing things for God because of <u>rules</u> in order to gain His approval. Instead obey and honor God because of your love <u>relationship</u> with Him.
