WITNESSING THAT MAKES SENSE Colossians 4:2-6

Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving; ³praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned; ⁴that I may make it clear in the way I ought to speak. ⁵Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of every opportunity. ⁶Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person. Colossians 4:2-6 (New American Standard Bible)

Three keys to witnessing that make sense

> WE WITNESS THROUGH OUR PRAYERS.

How should I pray?

- 1. Pray persistently.
- 2. Pray alertly.
- 3. Pray for <u>opportunities</u>. Be prepared for God to answer in unexpected ways. (See Philippians 1:12-14).
- 4. Pray for clarity.

So then, just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him. Colossians 2:6 (New International Version)

The Roman's Road to Salvation

- Every person is a sinner (Romans 3:23).
- God's penalty for sin is spiritual death (Romans 6:23).
- In His great love, God has made a provision for the forgiveness of sins and the salvation of all (Romans 5:8).
- Each person must put his or her trust in God's Son, Jesus Christ (Romans 10:9-10).

➤ WE WITNESS THROUGH OUR <u>CONDUCT</u>.

Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of every opportunity. Colossians 4:5 (NASB)

How should I live?

1. Live <u>wisely</u>. Remember that people are watching you. Don't give them an excuse to reject the Gospel.

Live such good lives among pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us.

1 Peter 2:12 (NIV)

2. Live with a sense of <u>urgency</u>.

"Redeeming the time" – capitalizing on every opportunity

> WE WITNESS THROUGH OUR **SPEECH**.

Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person. Colossians 4:6 (NASB)

How should I speak?

1. Speak graciously.

Instead, speaking truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. Ephesians 4:15 (NIV)

2. Speak intelligently.

Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect. 1 Peter 3:15b (NIV)
