Truth-Telling and Its One Exception

Worthless, wicked people go around telling lies. Proverbs 6:12 (Good News Translation)
Scripture gives believers **five assertions** about truth-telling.

Assertion #1: TRUTH-TELLING IS BASED ON THE <u>CHARACTER OF GOD</u>.

All your words are true . . . Psalm 119:160a (New International Version)

... the God of truth. Psalm 31:5 (NIV) and Isaiah 65:16 (NIV) (See also Psalm 43:3)

• Assertion #2: JESUS TEACHES HIS FOLLOWERS TO BE TRUTH-TELLERS.

But now I tell you: do not use any vow when you make a promise. Do not swear by heaven, for it is God's throne; ³⁵nor by earth, for it is the resting place for his feet; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. ³⁶Do not even swear by your head, because you cannot make a single hair white or black. ³⁷Just say 'Yes' or 'No'—anything else you say comes from the Evil One. Matthew 5:34-37 (GNT)

Jesus' point: Whatever <u>scheme you use</u> to avoid the truth, takes you in Satan's direction, not God's.

- Assertion #3: LYING HAS <u>CONSEQUENCES</u>.
 - Lying affects our relationship with God.

Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, but those who deal faithfully are His delight. Proverbs 12:22 (New American Standard Bible)

Lying affects our relationship <u>with others</u>.

A lying tongue hates those it hurts . . . Proverbs 26:28 (NIV) (See also Psalm 52:2; 119:69; Proverbs 13:5)

o Lying affects the one who lies most of all.

"A soothing tongue is a tree of life, but a deceitful tongue breaks the spirit." Proverbs 15:4 (GOD'S WORD Translation)

Assertion #4: TRUTH-TELLING IS <u>POSSIBLE</u>!

Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body. Ephesians 4:25 (NIV) (See also 1 Peter 2:1)

Four Practical Actions Will Help Believers Tell the Truth

Confront your <u>fears</u>.

Then the LORD said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh and say, 'Will I really have a child, now that I am old?' ¹⁴Is anything too hard for the LORD? I will return to you at the appointed time next year and Sarah will have a son." ¹⁵Sarah was afraid, so she lied and said, "I did not laugh." Genesis 18:13-15a (NIV)

Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place. Psalm 51:6 (NIV)

- Commit to the truth <u>ahead of time</u>. (See Ephesians 6:14)
- Think before you speak.

The godly think before speaking; the wicked spout evil words. Proverbs 15:28 (New Living Translation)

Seek forgiveness when you fail.

Blessed are those who have a tender conscience, but the stubborn are headed for serious trouble. Proverbs 28:14 (NLT)

• Assertion #5: THERE IS **ONE EXCEPTION** TO TRUTH-TELLING.

We have no moral obligation to tell the truth to <u>evil men</u> if it will helps them <u>do evil</u>.

The midwives answered Pharaoh, "Hebrew women are not like Egyptian women; they are vigorous and give birth before the midwives arrive." ²⁰So God was kind to the midwives and the people increased and became even more numerous. ²¹And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families of their own. Exodus 1:19-21 (NIV)

Do not let kindness and truth leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴So you will find favor and good repute in the sight of God and man. Proverbs 3:3-4 (NASB)
