- The Command: Impress.
- How: Teach.
- When: As you go!

## Principle #1: Teach Truth Intentionally.

Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it. Proverbs 22:6 (NIV)

- Observe
- Learn
- Experiment
- Plan

Principle #2: Talk Truth <u>Relationally</u>.

Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 6:7b (NIV)

## Principle #3: Transmit Truth Practically.

*Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.* <sup>9</sup>*Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.* Deuteronomy 6:8-9 (NIV)

- *"On your hands"* = <u>actions</u>
- "On your foreheads" = thoughts and attitudes
- *"On the doorframes"* = your home
- *"On your gates"* = life <u>outside the home</u>
  - > It's looking for "Teachable Moments."
  - Teachable moments won't produce meaningful lessons if the teacher isn't present.
  - > If our faith won't work at home, it won't work anywhere!
