ARE NEW TESTAMENT CHRISTIANS REQUIRED TO TITHE?

Two reasons the tithe continues for New Testament (NT) Christians

#1: God received tithes from Abraham before the Law was given. (See Genesis 14:18-20)

#2: Jesus reaffirmed the tithe in the New Testament.

"How terrible it will be for you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! For you are careful to tithe even the tiniest part of your income, but you ignore the important things of the law—justice, mercy, and faith. You should tithe, yes, but you should not leave undone the more important things." Matthew 23:23 (New Living Translation)

Principles of giving on the basis of God's grace . . .

#1: Every NT example of giving goes beyond the tithe. (See Acts 4:33)

For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, ⁴they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints. 2 Corinthians 8:3-4 (NIV)

#2: Grace always ups the standard.

But just as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us—see that you also excel in this grace of giving. 2 Corinthians 8:7 (NIV)
