When Your World Is Threatened

Psalm 121 offers three assurances of God's help on the journey of life.

Assurance #1: God Himself is our **Source** of Help.

I lift up my eyes to the hills--where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth. Psalm 121:1-2 (New International Version)

"... On what are you basing this confidence of yours? ³²... "Do not listen to Hezekiah, for he is misleading you when he says, 'The LORD will deliver us.'" 2 Kings 18:19,32b (NIV)

Hezekiah received the letter from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the LORD and spread it out before the LORD. ¹⁵And Hezekiah prayed to the LORD: "O LORD, God of Israel . . . You have made heaven and earth. ¹⁶Give ear, O LORD, and hear; ¹⁹. . . deliver us from his hand, so that all kingdoms on earth may know that you alone, O LORD, are God." 2 Kings 19:14-15,16a, 19b (NIV)

Assurance #2: His Help is Certain.

He will not let your foot slip--he who watches over you will not slumber; ⁴indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. ⁵The LORD watches over you—the LORD is your shade at your right hand; ⁶the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. Psalm 121:3-6 (NIV)

Assurance #3: His Help is Limitless.

The LORD will keep you from all harm . . . 8the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore. Psalm 121:7a, 8 (NIV)

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me . . . Psalm 23:4a (NIV)

For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure.

18 The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom 2 Timothy 4:6,18a (NIV)
