# Get in the Game!

Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10 (English Standard Version)

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. Ephesians 2:10 (New Living Translation)

Three principles in Ephesians 2:10 help us know what God says about getting in the game, about making a difference in life.

#### • Principle #1: YOU WERE CREATED TO MAKE <u>A DIFFERENCE</u>.

• God has <u>meaningful and purposeful things</u> for His people to accomplish during their life on planet earth.

"Created us anew in Christ Jesus . . ." = being born again, regeneration (See 2 Peter 1:4; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 2:15)

... he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, ... Titus 3:5 (ESV)

• Why did God save and transform you? So that you could do the good works that He has planned for you.

## Two Things That Last Forever

 $\hfill\square$  The Word of God

The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever. Isaiah 40:8 (ESV)

#### People's souls

I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life. 1 John 5:13 (ESV)

(See also Matthew 25:46; 2 Thessalonians 1:9 and 1 John 2:25)

• Principle #2: GOD HAS MADE THE <u>NECESSARY PREPARATIONS</u> FOR YOU TO GET IN THE GAME AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE.

# How has God prepared you ahead to make a difference?

- $\circ~$  God has given two basic resources that are available to every believer.
  - □ God's <u>Word</u>, the Bible (See 2 Timothy 3:16)

If you really keep the royal law found in Scripture, "Love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing right. James 2:8 (NIV)

□ God's Holy Spirit

• God has given the <u>necessary skills and gifts</u> needed for ministry.

Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. 1 Peter 4:10 (NIV)

#### Two Different Kinds of Gifts from God

- <u>Spiritual</u> gifts: a capacity granted by the Holy Spirit enabling a believer to serve others in a specific way
- □ <u>Natural</u> gifts: the result of genetics, which are ordained by God
- God has given life opportunities and experiences.

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, <sup>4</sup>who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God. 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 (NIV)

## • Principle #3: GETTING IN THE GAME REQUIRES <u>OBEDIENCE</u> TO GOD.

". . . that we should walk in them."

"Walk" = Greek = *peripateo* = "to walk" but also "to conduct your life in a certain way"
