The call to commitment is an important use of a timeline. See Joshua 24:19-20.

- WHEN A COMMITMENT IS MADE, ONE BECOMES AN <u>INTEGRAL</u> PART OF THE TIMELINE.
- WE BECOME A PART OF THE WITNESS OF ALL THAT GOD HAS DONE. See Joshua 4:21-24.
- **WHEN WE TAKE THE TIME TO <u>REMEMBER</u>, WE PASS THE STORY ON TO THE <u>NEXT GENERATION</u>.**
