The Big Picture:

Key Point for Galatians 6:6:

Honor and thank those in your life who are devoted to teaching your family about the **Word of God**.

Key Point for Galatians 6:7-9:

A life lived for God does not happen by <u>accident</u>, but includes intentionality, discipline, and endurance.

For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. Galatians 6:8 (ESV)

And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. Galatians 6:9 (ESV)

Key Point for Galatians 6:10:

Selfish and sinful desires prefer being served rather than serving others.
